Reporting absences.

In order to set up a specific email account for student absences, we'll get in touch with your IT provider. The phone system will subsequently be configured to give parents instructions, such as "push one to report an absence over the phone". The caller will then leave a voicemail message with the student's name and the reason for their absence, allowing the reception team to keep the phone lines available and deal with the absence at a later time. This can also be used for changes to end of school collection.
